Expectations for the 2020-21 school year

- There will be no field trips this year.
- Meetings will be held approximately once per month in the cafeteria or gym with students spread out for social distancing.
- Meetings will be held during the advisory and/or lunch period during school hours.
- Club activities will revolve around reading. Example activities could include discussion of favorite books, silent/aloud reading, book talks, touchless browsing of new books that are spread apart for social distancing, Google Classroom posts of new library books and links to eBooks, and other activities that promote reading while maintaining a healthy atmosphere.
- Remote students will not be able to participate in any in-person activities, but may join the Google Classroom to get information about eBooks, etc.

CLEARWATER HIGH SCHOOL BOOK CLUB CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

Article I. Name

1. The name of the organization is BOOK CLUB, hereafter referred to as the club.

Article II. Purpose of the Club

1. Promote reading.

Article III. Membership

1. Membership is open to any currently enrolled Clearwater High School student.
2. Current members may bring up new business during the open floor session of regularly scheduled meetings.

Article VI. Faculty Sponsors

1. There must be a faculty sponsor(s).
2. At least one sponsor must be present at all club meetings.
3. The role of the sponsor is to facilitate book discussions and oversee club activities.

Article V. Meetings

1. Meetings are generally held 6-8 times per year, usually on the first Friday of the month. Meeting frequency, locations, and times are subject to change at the discretion of the club sponsor(s).
2. At least one sponsor is required to attend each meeting.
3. Attendance will be taken at meetings.

Article VI. Activities

1. Meetings
2. Field Trips (optional)
3. Fundraisers (optional)

Article VII. Code of Ethics

1. The club shall operate under current school policies.

Article VIII. Changes to Bylaws

1. Articles in this set of bylaws may be deleted, modified, or added as deemed necessary by a majority of the club.
2. Bylaws may be amended at any regular meeting by a majority vote of present members, providing that the revision has been read to the group prior to the vote.
